A motion was made by Ted Juhl, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to approve the Stremick Tile Drain.

Discussion on the JF Complaint – deadline for completion of the removal of the obstruction was October 1. A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Ted Juhl, by vote unanimously carried that Johnson Farms did not comply with the order to remove and to hire Triple D Construction to remove the dike at Johnson Farms' expense.

Jeff Duray –Triple D Construction reported on projects – Drain 64 – discussion on the remaining dirt on the Edgar property and seeding. A motion was made by Richard Kendall, seconded by Ted Juhl, to hire Triple D Construction to estimate and complete FEMA repairs on the Drain 78 outlet. Duray also reported on the Drain 66 FEMA project.

The board reviewed the Warner culvert requests – No comment.

A motion was made by Ted Juhl, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to approve the Pembina County DOT ROW as presented.

A motion was made by Richard Kendall, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to approve the ND DOT ROW permit for Vivatson.

A motion was made by Ted Juhl, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to approve the amendment to Tongue River Snagging and Clearing to Miles 1 to 4 due to funding. Additional length to be determined at a later date.

A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Ted Juhl, by vote unanimously carried to approve the Wieler Dam gate materials.

A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Ted Juhl, by vote unanimously carried to accept the bid and award the bid to sole bidder On the Level for \$84,000.

Tree spraying on Drain 66 and Drain 4 will be scheduled for Summer 2021.

Discussion on the Drain 39 finances. A motion was made by Richard Kendall, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to seek bond financing for \$260,000 for 10 years for Drain 39 through AMKO financial.

Drain 62R – two washouts have been found that need repairs – fill material is needed and may be available through the township.

Manager Thacker reported that Kendall Construction had not yet fixed the Brown crossing.

Manager Juhl reported on Drain 6.

Attorney Fleming updated on the scheduled depositions.
