ANNUAL PREA REPORT AND ALLEGATION SUMMARY 2016

The Pembina County Correctional Center in 2016 housed 251 inmates. The average length of stay for the inmates was 155 days. Sixteen inmates were housed for a period greater than 30 days.

The Correctional center in 2016 housed 199 males and 52 females. The Pembina County Correctional Center also houses female inmates for the City of Grafton.

In 2016, the Pembina County Correctional Center added a Correctional Officer position to the jail staff in anticipation of the upcoming changes from the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

In January of 2017, the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation enacted new jail standards; one of the standards was that all correctional facilities in the state are mandated to become PREA compliant.

In 2017, our Dispatchers/Corrections personnel have received the required PREA training.

The Pembina County Corrections Center has not had a PREA incident in 2016, or any previous year.

The Pembina County Correctional Center will continue to strive for excellence, and the safety of inmates, and staff.
